DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Project includes, but is not limited to: Construction of approximately 400 feet of 18" storm drain piping and 500 feet of 15" sanitary sewer piping on the UC Berkeley Campus.

BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS: To allow the University to evaluate bidders, each bidder must submit, a Contractor's Special Statement of Experience. This Contractor's Special Statement of Experience must be provided on the Contractor's letterhead. ***If your firm provides inaccurate or incomplete information your firm will be found non-responsive. If your firm receives negative project references they may be found non-responsive.*** To be eligible to submit a bid, the Contractor's Special Statement of Experience must include.

- a. documentation that the bidder has successfully completed at least three (3) projects of similar or larger size and complexity during the last five (5) years, within the nine county Bay Area.
- b. the name, address and current phone number of the Owner's Representative on the three (3) submitted projects.
- c. Listing of all UC General Engineering projects completed during the last five (5) years.

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Bid, excluding alternates, shall accompany each Bid. The Surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the Bid Deadline, listed in the latest published State of California, Department of Insurance, list of *Insurers Admitted to Transact Surety Insurance in This State*.

A **MANDATORY Pre-Bid Conference and Site Visit** will be conducted on **Tuesday, October 6, 2009**, beginning promptly at **10:00 A.M.** Participants shall meet at the bus stop at the Haas School of Business on Gayley Road. Only bidders who participate in the Pre-Bid Conference in its entirety, will be allowed to bid on the Project as prime contractors.

**NOTE:** Prospective bidders will find that parking on campus may be difficult. The Owner recommends that you allow **ample time** to drive to the campus, find a parking space, walk to and locate the starting point from which the **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Site Visit will begin. Prospective bidders arriving late after the **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Site Visit has commenced (i.e., more than 15 minutes after the published starting time.) will not be allowed to submit a bid as a prime contractor for this project. Prospective bidders must be present for the **entire** Pre-Bid Site Visit.

The successful Bidder and its Subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage rates at the location of the Work.
