#### **No construction Thanksgiving Weekend**

Due to the holiday, there will not be a update next week.

#### **CURRENT AND UPCOMING**

\* The walkways (including concrete foundations) that were installed around the stadium for the football season are being removed. Removal is scheduled to be complete by the Thanksgiving holiday; crews may work longer days to meet that target.

\* Building forms for new walls continues. The next concrete pour for walls is scheduled for Nov. 25.

\* Work to install plumbing and electrical systems, including some excavation, is scheduled to begin as soon as the temporary walkways have been removed.

\* Work for underground utility installation near the north side of the I-House loading dock continues; the new storm drain line is now connected to the main line.

\* The small buildings on the east side of the Prospect Lot are scheduled to be demolished starting Nov. 23. Preparation for that work, including relocating some parking and fencing, is underway. The east side of the parking lot will be closed for construction, leaving the west side for some parking, vehicle access to the Stadium, and service access to adjacent residences. City parking spaces will not be impacted. Following demolition of the buildings, new support facilities will be built in the area.

#### **NEARBY CAMPUS CONSTRUCTION**

\* Maintenance activity, including fence modifications, and some paving and pruning, is scheduled to begin Dec. 1 around Witter Rugby Field (near the east rim of the Stadium and the intersection of Rimway and Centennial).
