

## REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

### UC Berkeley, Relocation of Campus Data Communication Center Project 12237A

The University of California, Berkeley is seeking a Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing (MEP) engineering firm with telecommunication design services and civil engineering design services (both either in-house or as a subconsultant) to provide overall design coordination and development of construction documents to relocate the campus Data Communications Center from Evans Hall to an existing space in a nearby campus building. The construction value of this work is estimated to be \$2,500,000.

The existing space is basically a shell with all support services currently under construction. This project will build-out the space to accommodate the Data Center, including:

1. Providing the structure modifications and infrastructure build-out for the Data Communication Center
2. Cut-over of the existing data communication services from the existing to the new facility.

The preliminary layout and telecom programming of the above described project is complete. The successful team will be required to start with the current documents and develop them to 100% construction documents. They will also be required to provide construction support services.

Construction of this work is anticipated to begin in July 2008.

### RESPONSE FORMAT

As a minimum, the Statement of Qualifications should include:

- General information about your firm
- General information about all firms comprising the team
- Specific experience in the kinds of work associated with this project. Identify projects, construction costs, duration and timeframe of the work, clients, project highlights.
- Proposed project team members, their experience in this kind of work and their resumes.

- We request that the responses have soft bound covers and that they be limited to about five pages plus resumes.

## SELECTION PROCESS

A selection committee will be appointed and they will review the Statements of Qualifications to select firms for interviews. It is anticipated that the initial review will require about one week and we expect to select no more than three firms for interviews.

The firms invited to the interview will receive more technical information about the project to enable them to prepare for the interview.

We expect to select the successful firm within one week of the interview process.
