

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

Clark Kerr Campus Utility Renewal
Project 12316B

The University of California, Berkeley is seeking a full service construction inspection services firm to provide special inspection services in support of the construction of buried utilities at the Clark Kerr Campus of the University of California. The construction contract value of this work is \$6,000,000.

The project installs several thousand feet of water system piping, communication and power ductbanks and sewer and storm drain piping. There is also a considerable amount of sewer pipe repair with both slip line and CIPP methods. Ranger Pipelines has already been selected for this project and work will begin in September, 2008.

The successful inspection services firm will be required to perform primarily special inspections of soil compaction and weld inspection of welded waterline piping. There will be other miscellaneous inspection services in support of the Campus Inspector of Record. It is anticipated that the successful firm will provide a full time special inspector for the duration of the project.

RESPONSE FORMAT

All firms responding to the request for qualifications must submit a Business Information Form to Facilities Services. The form is available on the Facilities Services Web Site at:

At a minimum, the Statement of Qualifications should include:

- General information about your firm (history, background)
- Firm and staff experience in the inspection of below grade utility construction.
- Specific experience in soil compaction testing and weld inspection related project work. Identify clients and projects, construction costs, duration and timeframe of the work
- Proposed project team members, their role in the subject project, their experience in this project type and their resumes.
- We request that the responses have soft bound covers and that they be limited to 5 pages plus resumes and appendix. (Hint: Ability to follow instructions is a key selection parameter).
- Please provide four copies of your qualifications package.

SELECTION PROCESS

A selection committee will be appointed and they will review the Statements of Qualifications to select firms for interviews. It is anticipated that the initial review will require about one week and we expect to select no more than three firms for interviews.

The firms invited to the interview will receive more technical information about the project and more specific selection criteria to enable them to prepare for the interview.

We expect to select the successful firm within one week of the interview process.
