

II RESPONSES TO COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT EIR

Public input was solicited at several points during the creation of the Draft Southeast Campus Integrated Projects Tiered Focused EIR. After the November 14, 2005 publication of the Notice of Preparation for the Draft EIR, UC Berkeley held a scoping meeting on December 8, 2005, to encourage public input on the scope of the EIR. In accordance with State law, the public scoping comment period extended for 30 days, closing on December 14, 2005.

For the Draft EIR itself, UC Berkeley established a 61-day review period, from publication on Monday May 8, 2006, through Friday July 7, 2006, 16 days longer than required by law. The public was invited to attend a public hearing on June 6, 2006, from 7 to 9 p.m. at the Haas School of Business on the Berkeley campus. At this hearing, the public was invited to offer oral and written comments on the Draft EIR.

Sections 11.2 thru 11.6 present each of the comment letters received on the Draft EIR, transcripts of comments submitted in oral testimony at the public hearing, and the University's response to each environmental comment. (In some instances, a comment expresses opinion or does not relate to an environmental issue; the response may then be merely "comment noted.") Section 11.2 includes written comments from federal, state, regional and local agencies; section 11.3 includes written comments from organizations; section 11.4 includes two petitions; section 11.5 includes written comments from individuals; and section 11.6 includes transcripts of oral comments by speakers at the public hearing. For ease of reference, comments are listed by category in Table 11-1.
